Aim:

Terms of Reference:

1. To develop and maintain the Institute's professional development policy and to identify the need for and to advise appropriate training to equip them.
2. To continuously review the industry training needs and advice, as necessary, on the way the Institute can best meet these requirements.

3. To consider ways and means to provide specific assistance in improvement of skills and talents of members.
4. To liaise, where appropriate, with other organizations and education bodies on matters related to professional practices for the construction management profession.
5. To organize events such as seminars, conference, forum, site and factory visit, etc. for continuing professional development for the members and the construction industry.
6. To improve and widen relevant knowledge, skills and qualities for the profession of construction managers.
7. To improve personal competence and enhance career profession of members.
8. To ensure CPD events are organized and provided to satisfy the Commission of Labour under Section 6BA (4), Cap. 59.
9. To ensure the CPD events cover legal and contractual aspects, safety & health and environmental protection issues and technical matters, etc. which are relevant to the construction professional.
10. To co-organize and as supporting organization to associated institutions and professional bodies for joint CPD events (institutions with MOU signed) and to pursue review and accredit CPD events organized by others.
