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| Programme Highlight | <p>On 15 April, 2019, the world watched a devastating fire engulfed Paris’s 850-year-old Notre Dame Cathedral, which was included in the United Nations Educational Scientific & Cultural Organization (UNESCO) world heritage list. Most of the cathedral’s centuries-old wooden roof was destroyed including its famous spire and the upper walls were severely damaged.</p> <p>In Hong Kong, current trends in adopting to re-use the heritage buildings to another uses under the “Revitalizing Historic Buildings Through Partnership Scheme” for Government-owned historic buildings have been implemented since 2008. Proper implementation of Fire Safety Management (FSM) is considered a long term and continuous solution in providing total fire safety after occupants move in such heritage buildings. Currently, there is no strict legal liability for the building owners to implement FSM, as some terms in fire safety are not yet</p> |
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| | <p>clearly defined. Under the Fire Services Ordinance (Cap. 95), building occupants are usually prosecuted for blocking of escape routes. However, this is only a small portion of maintenance schedule under housekeeping. Other aspects such as fire prevention, staff training, fire and emergency action and maintenance plan are not yet enforced in many premises, except for some licensed and registered premises. This technical seminar aims to explain the idea how to execute FSM in the heritage buildings.</p> |
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| <p>About the Speaker</p> | <p>: Mr. Louis Leung has been working in various public organizations and Government departments over 20 years including Hong Kong Baptist University, Architectural Services Department & Fire Services Department. He is now working in Energy Efficiency Office in Electrical & Mechanical Services Department. Also, he acts as a part-time lecturer/assessors in Vocational Training Council.</p> <p>He received his BEng in Fire Engineering in University of Central Lancashire, MSc in Intelligent Building & Management in Hong Kong University of Science & Technology, MSc in Fire & Safety Engineering in the Hong Kong Polytechnic University. And MA in Arbitration and Dispute Resolution in City University of Hong Kong.
