His thorough grasp of the NEC3 and other forms of contract have helped in his successful management of more than 50 construction projects.</p> <p>KH is an Accredited NEC3 ECC Project Manager and appointed by CEDD as the on-site NEC Consultant to provide advisory services for the Tseung Kwan O – Lam Tin Tunnel Project which is so far the largest civil engineering works contract using the ECC Option C in Hong Kong.</p> <p>KH has been involved in Target Cost and NEC Contracts since 2008. He is the Assignment Manager for the provision of NEC Advisory Services to a number of public works contracts and provides NEC training to ArchSD, EMSD, WSD, local contractors and consultants.</p>
Synopsis	<p>The Government of HKSAR has adopted the New Engineering Contract (NEC) for more than 50 public works and civil engineering projects since 2009 and will continue to use NEC for projects called in 2016 / 2017. Although projects benefit from the use of NEC, there are concerns in contract administration, particularly in target cost contracts.</p> <p>In October 2016, DevB promulgated a Practice Notes for NEC ECC to raise the awareness of common issues and to align practices in contract administration and project management for projects using the ECC across various stages from option selection, preparation of tender documents and tender assessment to construction.</p> <p>The seminar will discuss the practical issues, existing common problems with possible solutions and recommendations for effective implementation of the NEC.</p>
