1) The Election of Ir LAM Sai Hung, GBS, JP as an Honorary Fellow of HKICM

Ir Lam is currently the Permanent Secretary for Development (Works), Development Bureau, HKSAR Government. He is a civil engineer by profession and an experienced senior civil servant with profound knowledge and rich experience in the works field.

Ir Lam graduated from the Department of Civil Engineering, University of Hong Kong in 1983. He is fellow member of the Hong Kong Institution of Engineers, the Institution of Civil Engineers and the China Hong Kong Railway Institution.

Ir Lam joined the Government as an Assistant Engineer in 1986. He was promoted to Chief Engineer in 2009, to Government Engineer in 2012, and to Principal Government Engineer in 2014. He was Project Manager of the Hong Kong Island and Islands Development Office in the Civil Engineering and Development Department from June 2015 to August 2016. He was Director of Civil Engineering and Development from September 2016 to October 2018 before his appointment as Permanent Secretary for Development (Works).

In view of his position, experience and eminence, Ir Lam is well acquainted with government officials in both Hong Kong and China as well as senior members in the construction and engineering fields. Ir Ma is currently the CEO of NWS Holdings Ltd. He is a civil & structural engineer by profession and an experienced senior executive with profound knowledge and rich experience in civil and infrastructure business.

Ir Ma was the Acting Chief Executive Officer of Hong Kong-Shenzhen Innovation and Technology Park Limited prior to become CEO of NWS Holdings Ltd from January 2019. He joined the Government of the HKSAR in January 2014 as the Under Secretary for Development and was subsequently appointed as the Secretary for Development in February 2017 and remained in the post until June 2017. Prior to working with the Government of the HKSAR, Ir Ma was the Executive Vice-President for Civil and Infrastructure Business (Asia Pacific) of AECOM Asia Co Ltd. Ir Ma is a Fellow of the Hong Kong Institution of Engineers, the Institution of Civil Engineers, UK, the Institution of Structural Engineers, UK, the Chartered Institution of Highways and Transportation, UK and Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors, UK. He is also a Registered Professional Engineer in Hong Kong and a Chartered Engineer in the UK. Ir Ma holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Engineering (Civil) from The University of Hong Kong and a Master of Engineering degree in Transportation Planning from Monash University, Australia. He is an Honorary Professor of the School of Science and Technology of The Open University of Hong Kong and an Adjunct Professor of the Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering, Faculty of Construction and Environment of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University. Ir Ma was appointed as Justice of the Peace in 2014 and was awarded the Gold Bauhinia Star by the Government of the HKSAR in 2017.
