Aim:

- (i) To assist the Council to organize series of Practical Training (PT) events and courses for HKICM members aiming to enhance their professional knowledge and competency.
- (ii) To advise the Council on the development of policy in all matters relating to educational and professional training to construction management professionals, both members and non-members.

Terms of Reference:

1. To develop and maintain the Institute's professional development policy and to identify the need for and to advise appropriate training to equip them.
2. To continuously review the industry training needs and advice, as necessary, on the way the Institute can best meet these requirements.
3. To arrange educational and professional development activities, such as conferences, symposia, courses, seminars and workshops on various construction-related subjects for both HKICM members and non-members.

4. To consider ways and means to provide specific assistance in improvement of skills and talents of members.
5. To study the pathway and to work out essential arrangements and possible structured training for non-members to be the corporate membership of HKICM.
6. To liaise, where appropriate, with other organizations and education bodies on matters related to education, training and courses for the construction management profession.
7. To organize events such as seminars, conference, forum, courses, etc. for continuing professional training development for the members and the construction industry.
8. To improve and widen relevant knowledge, skills and qualities for the profession of construction managers.
9. To improve personal competence and enhance career profession of members.
10. To ensure PT events and courses are organized and provided to satisfy the Commission of Labour under Section 6BA (4), Cap. 59.
11. To ensure the PT events and courses cover legal and contractual aspects, safety & health and environmental protection issues and technical matters, etc. which are relevant to the construction professional.
12. To co-ordinate with associated institutions and professional bodies for joint PT events and courses and to peruse, review and accredit Training events organized by others.
